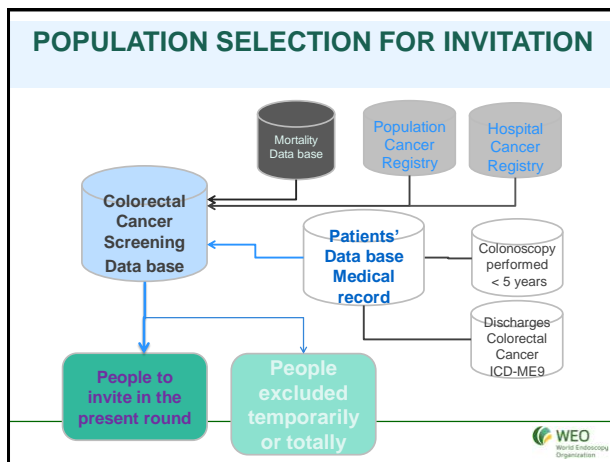
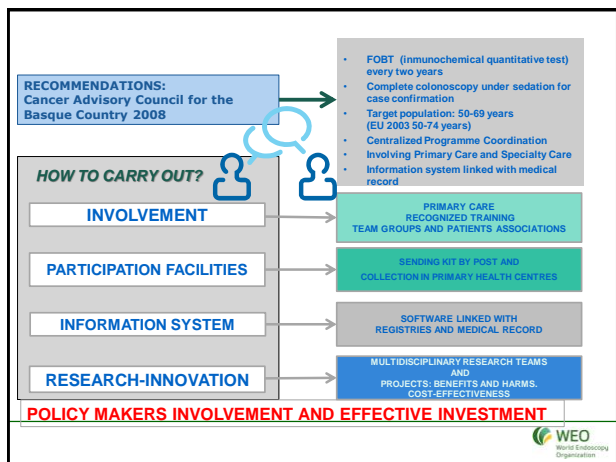

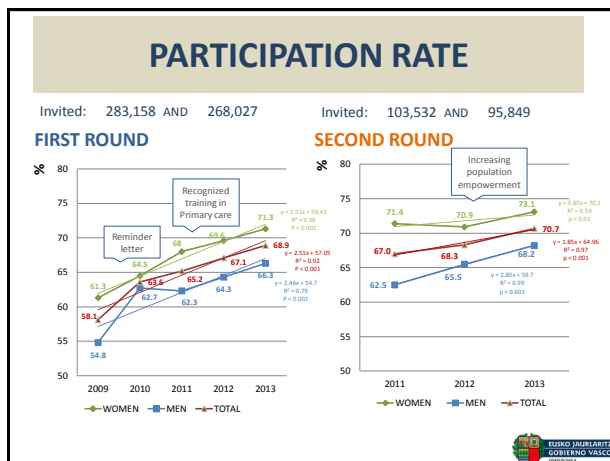

Cervical Cancer	Opportunistic	1999	65-82%

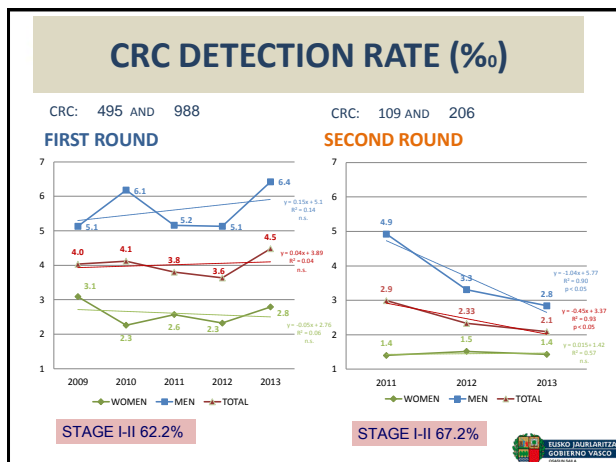
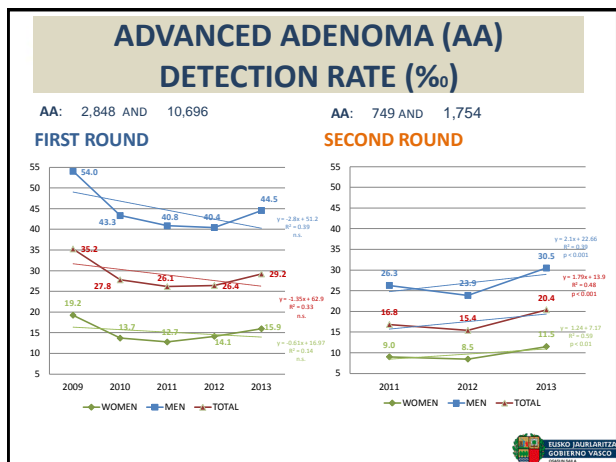
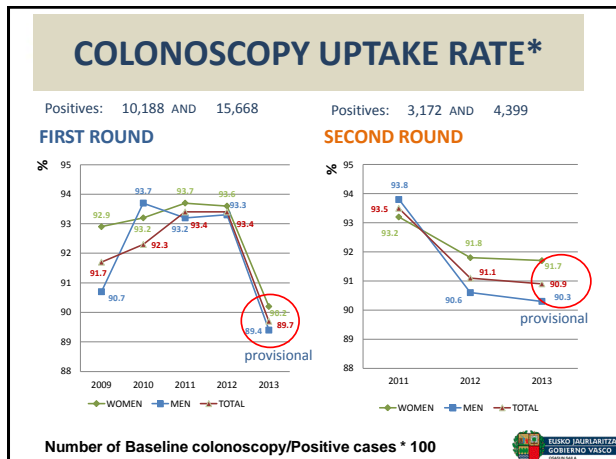
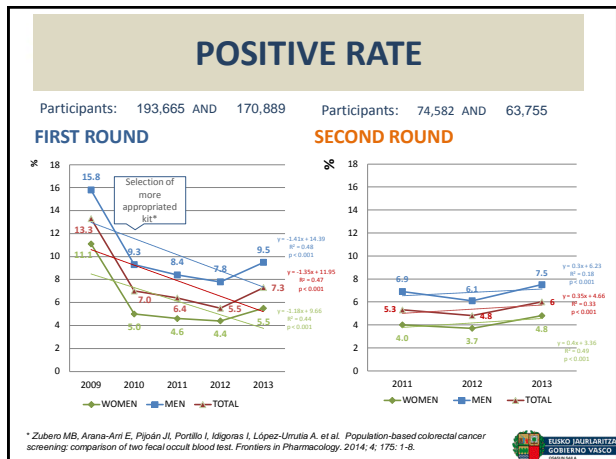

Cost/ person screened (participant)	72,220	33.57
Cost/ person with an Advanced Adenoma detected	1,927	1,258.16
Cost/ person with a CRC detected	288	8,418.29
Cost/ person with an Advanced Adenoma or CRC detected	2,215	1,094.57
